Coaching Experience

Kristen is the current head coach at Princeton University. She has served as head coach of the U16 USA National Team from 2000-2003 & 2005. As an assistant coach at The University of Iowa from 1998-2000, she helped guide the Hawkeyes to the NCAA Final Four in '99. Additionally, Kristen has served as a selector and coach at US National Team Trial Camps (A & B) dating back to 2000. In 2002, Kristen was sponsored by the US Field Association to attend the FIH Coach Course in Cologne, Germany.

Playing Experience

In December 2005, Kristen will compete in the 2005 Pan-American games as a member of the U.S. Women's Indoor National Team. This past summer (July 2005), Kristen competed in the Champion's Challenge in Virginia Beach as a member of the U.S. Women's Sr. National Team. Prior to that event, she was a member of the U.S. Women's Sr. National Team from '94-2000 and was also an alternate on the '96 US Olympic Team. As a 3 time All-American at the University of Iowa, Kristen led the Hawkeyes to 3 NCAA Final Four appearances. In '97, she played in the English Premier Hockey League with Olton Terraquest.

Scott is the current Associate Head Coach at Northeastern University. He also serves as the US Women's Indoor National Team Head Coach. In 2004, Scott was head coach of the New England Eclipse in the United Airlines Summer League. In 2000, he served as Assistant Coach at Georgetown University. Prior to that, Scott was head coach of both Men's & Women's teams at King's College, London.
