The virtual machine optionally retains the identity of the physical server (i.e., name, SID, disk configuration).

During this comprehensive hands on training, a Foedus VMware Certified Professional (VCP) will teach you the best practices surrounding the P2V migration process and explain how to use the VMware P2V Assistant and third-party imaging tools.
